- Attend monthly board meetings as a member of the fundraising subcommittee and staff meetings.

Marketing & Outreach

- Manage and create content for ACC social media accounts. (Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn, etc.)
- Write and send email newsletters and donor updates.
- Update ACC website with news, events, and stories.
- Design flyers, press releases, and promotional materials.
- Attend community gatherings to build relationships with community partners.
- Perform other related duties as assigned
